## Taiwan Scholarship (MOE Scholarship)

Best For Degree Seekers (Bachelor's, Master's, PhD)

**Duration** Undergrad: 4 Years / Master's: 2 Years / PhD: 4 Years

- **Tuition Waiver:** Up to NT\$40,000/semester(≈US\$1,300)

## Key Features

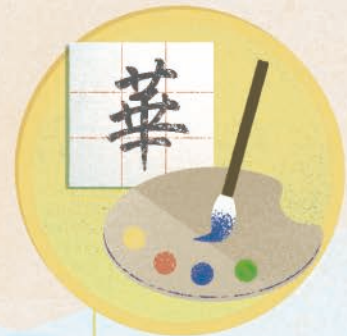
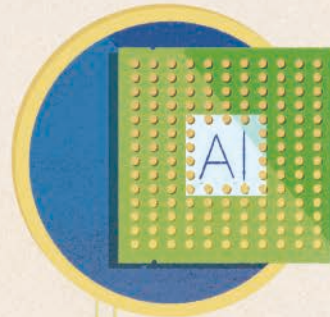

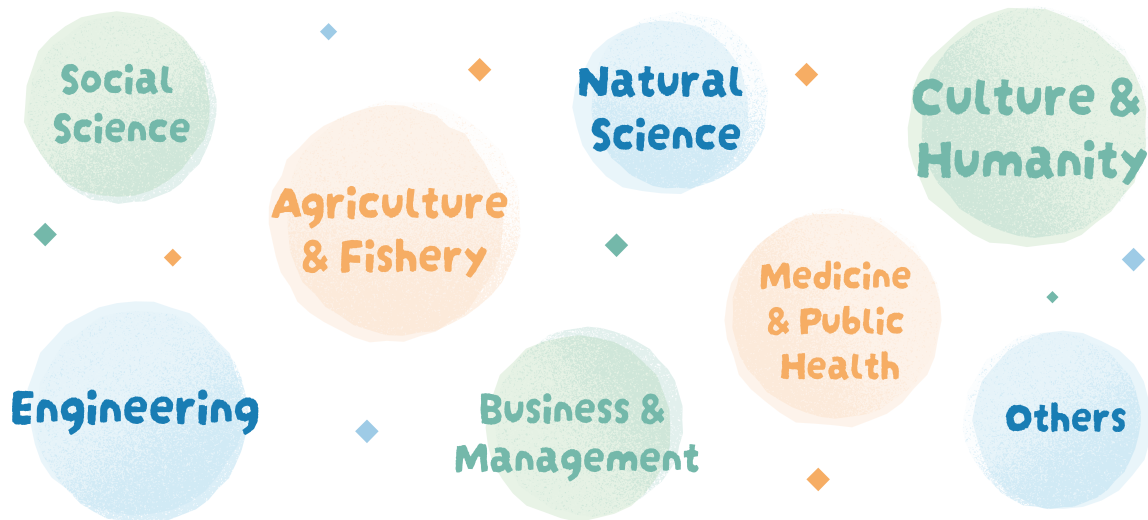


# TAIWAN EXPERIENCE EDUCATION PROGRAM (TEEP)
