

STUDYING IN TAIWAN

Taiwan's Education System


In Taiwan, students can pursue higher education at 2-year and 4-year colleges and universities. University and college undergraduate programs usually require 4 years of study; graduate programs leading to a master degree require 1 to 4 years, and doctoral programs require 2 to 7 years.

In most institutions of highe education, the academic year begins in August or Septembe and ends in July the following year. The academic year has two semesters: the first semester is from August usually to the following January, and the second semester begins in February and ends in July.
